

BIOGRAPHY OF EXHORTER ANGELA DALY

Angela M. Daly is one of three officially licensed Exhorters of Ebenezer A.M.E. Church of Brunswick. She was born and raised in the Brunswick, Maryland, community, and as such attended Brunswick Elementary and High School, graduating in 1989. Accordingly, she was named in the journal of "Who's Who Amongst America's High School Students."

She is the wife of Raymond L. Daly, Jr., who is also a licensed Exhorter of Ebenezer. Together they are the parents of six children, Elizabeth, Derek, Tara (deceased), Cory, Isaiah, and Mayah.

Exhorter Daly is the director and anointed soloist of Ebenezer's Senior Choir. She also serves on the Steward Board, the Church Strategic Planning Committee, and previously served on the Church Finance Committee.

Having given her life to Christ during her teen years, Exhorter Daly completed a certificate training program of spiritual studies at the Brunswick Satellite of Maple Springs Baptist Bible College and Seminary to enhance her foundational biblical knowledge.
